With 1,500 exhibitors from 32 countries occupying 180,000 m² of show space, 2,000 animals and 95,000 visitors from the farming industry, the SOMMET DE L'ELEVAGE is now recognised as a reference among the world's largest livestock shows.

Judging and animal presentations, technical innovations, business meetings, farmer events and conferences covering the hot topics in the agricultural world will, as they have for every year, form an integral part of this year's event that is already scheduled to be a success.

"The marketing for this year's show is going very smoothly and the SOMMET will, once again, be fully sold out with over 1,500 exhibitors" claims Fabrice BERTHON, the show's General Manager. If the SOMMET is in the process of setting a new record in terms of exhibitors, it can also legitimately hope to surpass the symbolic bar of 100,000 visitors over the 3 days of the fair in 2018. "In view of the 95,000 visitors who came to the show in 2017 and the current favourable economic climate in the dairy and beef sectors, the conditions appear favourable for attracting even more visitors this year".

The Salers breed national championship

In 2018, it's the turn of the Salers breed to host its national championship over the 3 days of the fair with 400 of the very best animals on show. Today the Salers breed numbers over 223,000 cows France.

The Simmental breed European championship

Other European Simmental breeders have replied positively to the proposal to organise a breed European championship at the SOMMET DE L'ELEVAGE.

4 countries will be represented: France, Germany, Austria and Switzerland with in total 48 animals in judging.

Note too that the livestock from Germany, Austria and Switzerland will be sold in auction at the end of the show.

Of course, all the other main breeds will be equally present with in total more than 2,000 premium animals, rigorously selected to participate in the numerous judging and other livestock presentations.

Conferences and symposiums at the heart of hot farming topics

As every year, the SOMMET will be the theatre for forty conferences dealing with current farming topics, not just involving livestock but also other varied themes.

At the same time as the Salers breed national championship, the SOMMET DE L'ELEVAGE will also host the Salers breed International Congress with almost 100 delegates expected from throughout the world. The programme includes: numerous farm visits, technical meetings covering, in particular, genomic selection and the AGM of the International Federation of the Salers Breeders Associations.

THE INTERNATIONAL ANGLE, THE PRIORITY AXIS OF DEVELOPMENT



With 4,500 foreign visitors from 85 different countries coming to the exhibition in 2017, the SOMMET DE L'ELEVAGE has firmly established itself as one of the world's leading livestock trade shows.

The foreign delegations are particularly pampered in the International Business Club that sets its stall each year in the prestigious Zénith d'Auvergne concert hall.

Hosted by ADEPTA, the International Lounge offers a number of services that reply specifically to the needs of the foreign visitor: interpreters, guided visits to the show, personalised advice and assistance, organised meetings with exhibitors, meeting rooms,

catering, prayer hall, accommodation booking service, free shuttle service... A team from BUSINESS FRANCE, comprising agricultural specialists based overseas, offers an advisory service to exhibitors in their approach to exporting. The agency promotes the SOMMET DE L'ÉLEVAGE event in several target countries such as in the Mediterranean basin, in Eastern Europe, in Latin America and in Asia. Finally, to assist international visitors in their logistical requirements (travel, accommodation, tourism, etc.), the show's organisers have commissioned the travel agency AGRILYS, the #1 French specialist travel agency in study tours for farmers.



Turkey, guest of honour at the SOMMET 2018 C

Following on from Iran in 2017, it is Turkey's turn as the guest of honour for this 27th edition of the SOMMET.

Agriculture is an important activity in the country worth 52 Bn USD, representing 6.1% of the country's GDP and involving 19.4% of the active population or, 5.5 M persons, in 2017. Crops account for more than 2/3rds of its agricultural production, followed by livestock accounting for a 1/4, 5% in forestry and just 3% for fishing. Benefitting from a very wide variety of microclimates and 23,4 M ha of farmland, the country is more or less self-sufficient in many farm products. In 2017 Turkey's farm production included 50.5 MT* of forage grass, 35.1 MT of cereals, 30.8 MT of vegetables, 20.8 MT of sugar beet, 20.6 MT of fruit, 4.8 MT of potatoes, 3.7 MT of oil seeds, 2.4 MT of cotton, 1.3 MT of legumes and 1.3 MT of tea. This notable agricultural production places Turkey in 7th position in the world agricultural economy. In terms of livestock production, Turkey is a significant livestock-rearing country with 34 M sheep, 16 M cattle (of which 6 M are dairy cows) and 10 M goats. Bearing in mind its importance, livestock farming is one of the Turkish Ministry of Agriculture's priorities, focussing a significant percentage of its farm support towards its development.

"France and Turkey are complementary," explains Benoît Delaloy, the SOMMET's International Manager. "French beef breeds are appreciated by Turkish farmers because of their excellent yield and their lean meat. I sincerely hope that this invitation as guest of honour will contribute to further developing the exchanges between our two countries".

To be noted, on the fringe of the SOMMET DE L'ELEVAGE will be held the French-Turkish Joint Agricultural Committee between the respective Ministries of Agriculture for the two countries plus an Agri-business forum involving French and Turkish businesses. * MT = million tonnes
