Class 1 – Spring Heifer Calf born between 3/1/2017 and 5/31/2017

Class 2 - Winter Heifer Calf born between 12/1/2016 and 2/28/2017

Class 3 - Fall Heifer Calf Born between 9/1/2016 and 11/30/2016

Class 4 – Summer Yearling born between 6/1/2016 and 8/31/2016

Class 5 - Spring Yearling born between 3/1/2016 and 5/31/2016

Class G – Winter Yearling born between 12/1/2015 and 2/29/2016

Class 7 – Fall Yearling born between 9/1/2015 and 11/302015

Awards will be given for all class winners along with Champion and Reserve, Best Bred and Owned and Reserve. There will also be a Genomic Merit Award.

GENOMIC MERIT AWARD: Genomics has become an important part of many breeding programs. Because of this, the National Brown Swiss Association has developed and will sponsor a new award to recognize the highest genomic heifer at a national show. The inaugural show for the award will be the 2017 National Heifer Show held in conjunction with the National Convention in Canton, Ohio. The award will be based on a combination of genomic PPR, genomic SNM and the show placing. To be eligible for the award, the exhibitor must send the complete genomic test results for their animal into the National Brown Swiss Office by June 20, 2017. The winner will be selected from only the entries sent to the National Office. If the award is well received, it will be implemented at all National Brown Swiss shows in 2018.
